Decadal Agromet Bulletin of Pakistan



Highlights....

- Light to moderate rainfall reported from most parts of Balcohistan, however light rainfall reported from Punjab, KP, Sindh, G.B & Kashmir during the last decade.
- Highest amount of rainfall recorded as 37.3mm at Quetta during the last decade.
- ♦ Lowest minimum temperature recorded as -7.5°C at Kalam during the last decade.
- Light to moderate rain (with snowfall over the mountains) is expected in most parts of the country, while weather may remain cloudy in the northern and western parts of the country during the current decade.
- Wheat crop is at tillering-maturity stages in different areas. Farmers are advised to schedule their irrigation plans by keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Farmers in the lower half of the country especially those in central regions are advised to take up poultry rearing houses to maintain optimum room temperature and take care against the rapid changes in air temperature and relative humidity.
- Removing weeds from the standing crops is very important as weeds utilize moisture and food which are to be utilized by the crop. As a result considerable loss in yield occurs every year.
- Farmers are advised to ensure field sanitation and spray prophylactic fungicidal sprays to prevent spread of diseases on vegetable.

Past Weather (11th to 20th March, 2017)

Light to moderate rainfall reported from most parts of Balcohistan, however light rainfall reported from Punjab, KP, Sindh, G.B & Kashmir during the last decade.

1.1 Punjab

Light rainfall reported from agricultural plains of Punjab. Chief amount of rainfall received at DG Khan, Mangla & Murree. Decadal maximum & minimum both dropped below normal by 3.0°C & 3.2°C respectively, in the province. Whereas mean values of relative humidity, sunshine hour, wind speed & ETo were recorded as 51%, 75.9hrs, 3.5km/hr and 3.4mm/day respectively.

1.1 Sindh

Light rainfall reported from agricultural plains of Sindh. Chief amount of rainfall received at Dadu, Padidan & Larkana. Decadal maximum & minimum both dropped below normal by 2.2°C & 2.7°C respectively, in the province. Whereas mean values of relative humidity, sunshine hour, wind speed & ETo were recorded as 41%, 88.7hrs, 4.3km/hr and 3.5mm/day respectively.

1.2 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP)

Light rainfall reported from agricultural plains of KP. Chief amount of rainfall received at Parachinar, Kohat & Kalam. Decadal maximum & minimum both dropped below normal by 1.6° C & 3.8° C respectively, in the province, in the province. Whereas mean values of relative humidity, sunshine hour, wind speed & ETo were recorded as 61%, 67.1hrs, 5.1km/hr and 3.4mm/day respectively.

1.3 Balochistan

Light to moderate rainfall reported from agricultural plains of Balochistan. Chief amount of rainfall received at Quetta, Khuzdar & Lasbela. Decadal maximum & minimum both dropped below normal by 3.4°C & 1.5°C respectively, in the province. Whereas mean values of relative humidity, sunshine hour, wind speed & ETo were recorded as 48%, 70.6hrs, 8.5km/hr and 4.4mm/day respectively.

1.4 Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light rainfall reported from agricultural plains of GB & Kashmir. Chief amount of rainfall received at Kotli, Garhi Dopatta & Rawalakot. Decadal maximum & minimum both dropped below normal by 2.4°C & 1.6°C respectively, in the province. Whereas mean values of relative humidity, sunshine hour, wind speed & ETo were recorded as 42%, 61.9hrs, 3.6km/hr and 2.5mm/day respectively.

2(a) <u>Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains</u> (11th to 20th March, 2017)

2.1 RAMC, Rawalpindi (Potohar region)

Rainfall reported as Trace (not measureable) during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 09days. Average relative humidity recorded as 49%. Mean day temperature was 24.5°C while night temperature recorded as 8.6°C with 81.2hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 4.6km/hr with mean wind direction *westerly*.

2.2 RAMC, Faisalabad (Central Punjab)

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 06days. Average relative humidity recorded as 52%. Mean day temperature was 26.1°C while night temperature recorded as 10.4°C with 77.5hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 2.0km/hr with mean wind direction *south westerly*.

Wheat: Very Good condition, milk maturity stage.

2.3 RAMC, Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 06days. Average relative humidity recorded as 47%. Mean day temperature was 32.6° C while night temperature recorded as 12.3° C with 90.3hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 4.5km/h with mean wind direction *northerly*.

Wheat (Imdad): Harvested on 19.03.2017.

2.4 RAMC, Usta Muhammad (Eastern Balochistan)

Rainfall reported as Trace (not measureable) during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 03day. Average relative humidity recorded as 54%. Mean day temperature was 30.2°C while night temperature recorded as 13.8°C. Wind speed recorded as 11.2km/h with mean wind direction *southerly*.

Wheat: Very Good condition, milk maturity stage.

2.5 RAMC, Quetta (Northern Balochistan)

Rainfall reported as 40.8mm during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 09days. Average relative humidity recorded as 41%. Mean day temperature was 16.6°C while night temperature recorded as 5.2°C with 70.6hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 5.8km/hr with mean wind direction *north westerly*.

2(b)Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural
Plains (11th to 20th March, 2017)2.6Jhelum

Rainfall reported as 2.6mm during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 09days. Average relative humidity recorded as 51%. Mean day temperature was 26.5° C while night temperature recorded as 9.7° C with 75.1hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 4.0km/hr with mean wind direction *south westerly*.

2.7 Lahore

Rainfall reported as Trace (not measureable) during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 09days. Average relative humidity recorded as 58%. Mean day temperature was 25.6°C while night temperature recorded as 12.6°C with 72.5hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 2.4km/hr with mean wind direction *north westerly*.

2.8 Sargodha

Rainfall reported as Trace (not measureable) during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 8days. Average relative humidity recorded as 56%. Mean day temperature was 26.4°C while night temperature recorded as 12.1°C with 70.4hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 2.6km/hr with mean wind direction *westerly*.

2.9 Multan

Rainfall reported as Trace (not measureable) during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 08days. Average relative humidity recorded as 44%. Mean day temperature was 27.1°C while night temperature recorded as 14.7°C with 85.5hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 4.7km/hr with mean wind direction *southerly*.

2.10 Khanpur

Rainfall reported as 2.2mm during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 06days. Average relative humidity recorded as 46%. Mean day temperature was 29.6°C while night temperature recorded as 12.3° C with 69.0hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 4.4km/hr with mean wind direction *northly*.

2.11 Sakrand

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 04days. Average relative humidity recorded as 40%. Mean day temperature was 31.3° C while night temperature recorded as 11.8° C with 97.8hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 6.5km/hr with wind direction *northly*.

2.12 Rohri

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 03days. Average relative humidity recorded as 37%. Mean day temperature was 30.1°C while night temperature recorded as 16.0°C with 78.0hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 1.6km/hr with wind direction *north easterly*.

2.13 D.I. Khan

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 05days. Average relative humidity recorded as 56%. Mean day temperature was 27.1°C while night temperature recorded as 10.9°C with 73.2hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded 7.1km/hr with wind direction *south easterly*.

2.14 Peshawar

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 07days. Average relative humidity recorded as 66%. Mean day temperature was 25.5°C while night temperature recorded as 9.6°C with 61.0hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 3.1km/hr with mean wind direction *north westerly*.

2.15 Skardu

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 10days. Average relative humidity recorded as 47%. Mean day temperature was 11.8° C while night temperature recorded as -0.1° C with 60.0hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 2.9km/hr with mean wind direction *south south-easterly*.

2.16 Gilgit

Dry weather reported during the decade; however weather remained cloudy for 10days. Average relative humidity recorded as 37%. Mean day temperature was 17.4° C while night temperature recorded as 3.9° C with 63.7hours bright sunshine duration. Wind speed recorded as 4.2km/hr with mean wind direction Easterly.

3 <u>Ten Days Weather Advisory for Farmers</u> (21st to 31st March, 2017)

3.1 <u>Temperature Forecast</u>

Day temperature is slightly normal or above normal and night temperatures are expected to slightly normal in most of the agricultural plains of the country during the decade.

3.2 Wind Forecast

Normal wind pattern may prevail in most of the agricultural plains of the country during the decade.

3.3 Rain Forecast

- Punjab: Mainly dry weather is expected in most parts of the province. However light to moderate rainfall is expected from 21st to 22nd and from 28th to 30th of the decade.
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Mainly cold and cloudy weather is expected in most parts of the province during the decade.
- Sindh: Mostly dry weather is expected in the agricultural plains of province.
- Balochistan: Mainly cold and cloudy weather is expected in most parts of the province however light rainfall is expected at most places of Balochistan from 21st to 23rd and from 25th to 28th of the decade.
- Gilgit Baltistan: Mainly cold and cloudy weather is expected in most parts of G.B however light to moderate rain with snowfall is expected at scattered places during the current decade.

Kashmir: Mainly cold and cloudy weather is expected in most parts of the Kashmir however light to moderate rain with snowfall is expected at Muzzaffarabad and Rawalakot regions during the current decade.

***** 3.4 <u>Advisory for Farmers</u>

- Wheat crop is at shooting-maturity stages in different areas. Farmers are advised to schedule their irrigation plans by keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Farmers in the lower half of the country especially those in central regions are advised to take up poultry rearing houses to maintain optimum room temperature and take care against the rapid changes in air temperature and relative humidity.
- Removing weeds from the standing crops is very important as weeds utilize moisture and food which are to be utilized by the crop. As a result considerable loss in yield occurs every year.
- Farmers are advised to ensure field sanitation and spray prophylactic fungicidal sprays to prevent spread of diseases on vegetable.

4.1 Precipitation Outlook (21st to 23rd March, 2017)

The forecast for the first three days (21st to 23rd) of the third decade of March 2017 shows that light rainfall (with snowfall over the mountainous regions) is expected at isolated places of upper Punjab, KP, north & western Balochistan, GB and Kashmir. However dry weather is expected in rest parts of the country.



4.2 Precipitation Outlook (24th to 31st March, 2017)

The outlook for the last eight days (21st to 31st) of the third decade of March 2017 shows that light to moderate rainfall is expected at isolated places of Upper Punjab, KP, Balochistan, GB & Kashmir while dry weather may prevail in rest parts of the country.



Findings of AgMIP Paksitan, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad

- There would be significant increase in temperature i.e., 2.8°C in day and 2.2°C in the night during mid-century (2040-2069)
- There would be significant variability in rainfall patterns (about 25% increase in summer & 12% decrease in winter during 2040-2069)
- Climate Change will affect the crop yields negatively (about 17% for rice and 14% for wheat)
- If there will be no adaptation to Climate Change, majority of farmers would be the economic losers
- With Adaptation to Climate Change (through technology and management), there would be significant decrease in poverty and improvement in the livelihood of farming community.
